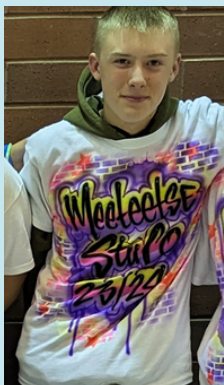
SOUTHEAST REGIONAL REP: ADDISON SCOTT
